Racing – Important Bits

1. **Fleets** must attach their **coloured ribbon** to the **masthead**

Fleet	Classes
1	Fast Singlehanders (inc all ILCAs) - PYS 1300 and under
2	Doublehanders (inc Fevas)
3	Toppers
4	Slow Singlehanders (inc Optimist & Tera) PYS 1301 and over

2. **Briefing:** **10:20** On the Pontoon

3. **Races:–** Series-1 **11:00** Series-2 **12:00** Series-3 **13:30** Series-4 **14:00**
Each Series having Four (4) Fleet-Starts at 5-minute intervals

4. **Safety:** Buoyancy Aids **MUST BE WORN** at all times.
No running on Pontoon or Slipway
Footwear compulsory
Notify all **Retirements** soonest.
Do Not sail to West (behind) the pontoons (which are **Obstructions**)

5. **Course:** Displayed on the club pontoon and on the starting raft if being used.
coloured boards with **white characters**.
colour of **background** (**red** or **green**) indicates the **side** (**port** or **starboard**).
Number of **rounds** shown by a **white figure** on a **black background**.

6. **Marks:** Buoys shown on **Chart**

7. **Starting:** **5(sound)–4(sound)–1(BELL)–Go(sound) !** (No Flag-X)

•**Pontoon:** Through **White post behind** & **Red/White striped in front** of Race-Box
... with **Inner & Outer** distance-marks

•**Raft:** **Yellow Flag** shown on Pontoon (**Go To the Raft** for Starting)
Signal-post to **Outer** distance-mark (Inner distance-mark included)

•**Exclusion:** Buoys marked with '**X**' to leeward of start-line; **KEEP-OUT** before Prep.Signal

8. **Penalties:** Boat-on-Boat **ONE-Turn only**

Judging = An on-water Judge-boat may monitor racing

Protests = ARBITRATION will be available through the Judges,
without necessity for form-filling.

= Full Protest Time-Limit of 30-mins after last series-finisher
Forms available from Race-Officer's box.

9. **Finish:** Between **Front Post** on Pontoon to **Yellow** inflatable
Whiskey-Flag finishing may be used, without displaying the flag.
